

TIC's Leadership Training Program

The Leadership Training Program (LTP) aims to help build strong individuals and leaders who are prominent contributors to their extracurricular activities, schools, or other communities.

What is the LTP?

The Leadership Training Program is an opportunity for campers to learn and practice vital leadership skills such as public speaking, acting appropriately in professional situations, good listening practices, goal setting, and making great first impressions. The Program runs during the camp day in 30-45 minute sessions, and is offered at no extra cost. Sessions are a mix of discussions, hands-on workshops, role playing, and more! The LTP curriculum also varies depending on the group of participants and what they are most interested in accomplishing, bringing TIC's focus on the individual into our long-standing emphasis on offering opportunities for leadership skills development.



Who can participate in the Leadership Training Program?

The LTP is offered for Rising 9th graders that are also at least 13 years old. The Program runs for one 2-week session, and is offered all 4 sessions of the summer, so any rising 9th graders enrolled at TIC are eligible to apply. All applicants that submit their applications by April 15th are accepted into the program. After April 15th, applicants will be accepted based on available space. LTP participants are still considered campers and are not given extra responsibilities at camp. They participate in regular sports and technology activities, but are taken out of their activities (generally during the morning) for 30-45 minutes per day for leadership training.

Why participate in the Leadership Training Program?

The Leadership Training Program provides individualized, experiential leadership training designed especially for teenagers and taught by young adults who are leaders in their own communities. At TIC, we aim to provide our campers with tools to reach their full potential as they continue to grow and eventually enter adulthood. We believe the skills we cover are important lifelong skills, and are also abilities that will help set them apart as young adults, whether it be at a job or college interview, a leadership position in their community, or in whatever area they choose to pursue. We also feel that these skills, (especially the communication skills) will be particularly helpful as participants enter a pivotal part of their teen years and begin High School.

Although the Leadership Training Program is not a prerequisite for the more rigorous Counselor-in-Training Program we offer for rising 10th graders, it does provide a useful base on which to build further training.
